Public Swimming Pool/Spa Chemistry Log Sheet

Please use this chart to record pool chemistry reading as well as any service and maintenance activities. Chlorine and pH readings must be taken and recorded at least once every day that the pool is open (more often is the pool is heavily used). Free Available Chlorine (FAC) must be between 1.5 and 5 parts per millon; pH must be between 7.2 and 8. Please contact us if you have any questions regarding the operation of your pool. A DPD test kit must be used to measure FAC. Please be sure you are using the correct kit. OTO kits are not acceptable.
