Violation: IMPROPER COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURE(S) [HSC 113996]

Description/Corrective Action: The michoaoacana frozen popsicles were observed with evidence of thawing and being refrozen. All these items need to be returned for store credit and the unit should be evaluated to make sure it can maintain items frozen at all times. Do not unplug this unit for any reason.
Place a sign over it stating these items are NOT FOR SALE. Only after new product is delivered can you remove the sign.

Violation: RESTROOM FACILITIES NOT MAINTAINED [HSC 114250 & 114276]

Description/Corrective Action: The restroom was observed in need of deep cleaning. No hot water was present and no paper towels were available.

Violation: IMPROPER MAINTENANCE OF FACILITY OR EQUIPMENT [HSC 114161-114182 & 114257]

Description/Corrective Action: Clean the store on a daily basis to remove excess dust. Sweep and mop the floor regularly. Dust counters and surfaces where dry prepackaged food and snacks are displayed.

Violation: UNNECESSARY ITEMS AND LITTER (HSC 114257.1)

Description/Corrective Action: Equipment that is not in use should not be stored inside the facility unless it is going to be kept clean. The empty freezer, pizza oven, heating oven and other equipment noted over counters has excess dust and debris. Remove these items or keep them in the storage area outside and keep all areas of the store sanitary.

General Comments:

Refrigeration units were noted at 40F.

The hand sink near the front counter had soap, paper towels and hot water. These items are also needed for the restroom sink as noted above.

Correct the noted violations within 2 weeks. A re-inspection will be conducted on or after 2/28/22 to verify compliance. One re-inspection is done at no charge and any additional inspections are billed at \$226 each. If you have any questions, call our department at 559-584-1411.
